



PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION OPEN IN DISTRICT 181

- Sessions five days per week, with a.m. session for 3's and p.m. session for 3's and 4's.
- Cost: \$250 per month for five day a week instruction.

To be enrolled, children must be 3 years old by September 1, 2012.
