

To be part of the Student Council Team please read the requirements below;

I would like to join the Student Council at The Lane School for the school year of 2011-2012. I understand the following expectations stated below and will follow them to the best of my ability. If I fail to abide by these expectations, I may be asked to give up my position as a student council member.

- 1) I will attend ALL meetings which will be held on Fridays at lunch. See the Student Council link on thelanepsto.org website for dates..
- 2) I understand I may be asked to attend other meetings before or after school.
- 3) I will abide by The Lane School creed to be responsible, respectful, and kind.
- 4) I understand as a member of student council it is my responsibility to stimulate and develop good citizenship and democracy among students.
- 5) I will demonstrate leadership ability. This means I can manage my school work and show responsibility in all academic areas.
- 6) I am in the **fourth** or **fifth** grade only and can sign up for student council regardless of whether I have held a position before.
- 7) I am ready to contribute ideas to make this a greener school.
- 8) I am ready to serve the needs of other schools, or organizations that may need help and to also promote safety and school spirit.

There will be two teams in which you may serve regarding student council. Descriptions of those are listed below.

We are limiting the number of student council members to forty. We would like to be fair and have twenty students from both fourth and fifth grades. If numbers reach well above that limit, we will go to a lottery system.

GREEN TEAM

This committee is responsible for keeping the school clean, both inside and out.

They will also contribute to the recycling at school and come up with ideas to increase the amount of recycling at our school.

They will provide “green” ideas to the fifth grade school store leaders who are selling recycled school supplies. They will educate the school community on earth friendly events.

They will oversee the pop tab collection, contribute to the Green Fair which is held at CHMS in the spring, and create other “green” ideas the whole school may participate in.

SERVICE TEAM

This committee will be responsible for the publicity in spreading the word about what is discussed at Student Council meetings.

They will promote school spirit with our “Spirit Days”

They will oversee service projects that EACH grade will participate in and organize events that will benefit those in need.

They will be updating information on our Student Council website and informing the PTO about upcoming events.
